City of Walthourville Mayor and Council Workshop Summary May 13, 2025 from 4:00 PM-5:45 PM Walthourville Police Department

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:07 PM by Mayor Sarah B. Hayes.
- II. Roll Call: The Roll was taken by the City Clerk. In addition to Mayor Hayes, the following members were present:

Councilmember Mitchell Boston Councilmember Bridgette Kelly

Councilmember Patrick Underwood Councilmember Robert Dodd

The attendance of the Council constituted a quorum.

Mayor Pro Tem Lovette entered the meeting at 4:13 PM.

Attorney Luke R. Moses was present.

- III. Policies: The Mayor and Council convened to establish and set policies that they identified as needed for the city. The following policies were discussed and would be drafted by the City Attorney.
 - Department Heads must attend the first Mayor and Council meeting of the month.
 - Monthly Financial Statement including bank balances, debt owed and outstanding bills.
 - All City Employees and Elected Officials must use a city-issued email address.
 - Capital Improvement Plan for infrastructure, estimated cost, and a strategic plan including cost savings practices to establish reserve funds.
 - Emergency Response Plan including an on-call roster for Essential Personnel.
 - Annual Budget Adoption Timeline
 - Reserve Fund identifying the usage of the fund and preparing for three to four months of operating expenditure.
- IV. Financial Update: Mr. Eon Wyk of CKH, (City CPA Firm) joined via TEAMS to provide a Financial Update. Mr. Wyk referenced the city has \$780,000.00 currently in unpaid bills. From his calculations as the city's CPA, the city will be 1.2 million dollars short. He added that if the millage is voted in, the city will still occur a shortfall this year. Mr. Wyk's recommendation is to find a way to increase revenue and cut costs. The Mayor and Council decided on May 20, 2025, to hold a FY 2025 Budget Amendment Meeting from 6:00 PM-8:00 PM. This meeting could entail cutting personnel and potentially eliminating departments.
- V. The Mayor and Council entered Executive Session for Litigation at 5:15 PM and exited at 5:50 PM.

VII. Agenda Items

1. LCPC Mrs. Lori Parks. Ms. Parks presented a temporary Business License Request for Branded Image. They are located in Nashville; Tennessee and they were hired by El Cheapo Convenience Store to restore their outdoor signage. Branded Image will use a three-man crew to perform the work. The motion to approve was made by Councilmember Kelly and the second was added by Councilmember Dodd. Vote: 5-0: Motion Passed Unanimously.

2. LCPC Mrs. Lori Parks

Mrs. Parks presented a one-time event permit for the First Annual Seafood Fest. The event will be held on May 16th and 17th, 2025 and will be held at the former BoMaz Club. The organizer of the event is Mrs. Brenda Howell. Mrs. Howell was present and stated she is excited about this event and all vehicles will be inside the fence. She has a lease, and she will have security (Security Personnel were present with her). Mrs. Howell added she will be having additional events; she promotes a safe environment for her events. There will be no weapons, and no alcoholic beverages will be served. The event will be on Friday May 16th from 4:00 PM-9:00 PM and Saturday May 17th from 12 Noon-9:00 PM. There will be vendor trucks at the festival. The motion to approve was made by Councilmember Dodd and the second was added by Councilmember Kelly.

- 3. City of Walthourville Councilmember Bridgette Kelly Councilmember Kelly stated the city only received one bid for the Auditor's RFP. The company was James Moore, LLC out of Gainesville, Florida. The motion to approve and hire the firm from Jesup, GA to conduct audits for FY 2021-2024 was made by Mayor Pro Tem Lovette and the second was added by Councilmember Kelly. Vote: 5-0: Motion Carried Unanimously.
- 4. City of Walthourville Mayor and Council Mayor Hayes stated the city needed to act on the IGA with the City of Hinesville. The motion to approve was made by Mayor Pro Tem Lovette and the second was added by Councilmember Boston. This authorization entails an IGA with the City of Hinesville for the city's Sewer Pumping Capacity.
 Vote: 5-0: Motion Passed Unanimously.

Also, a motion was made that effective immediately all developers must pay the new sewer and tap in fee rate of \$8,550.00. This new rate supersedes anyone that was grandfathered in and is effective as of 05-13-2025. The motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Lovette and the second was added by Councilmember Dodd.

VIII. Department Updates

- 1. Water Department: Mayor Hayes reported that delinquent disconnections occurred on May 12, 2025 and there were 94 disconnections. The Water Department is restoring services as the customers pay their bill.
- 2. Fire Department Chief Nicolas Maxwell Reported the Fire Department is progressing well. According to the statistics from the last meeting, the department has answered 26 total calls, consisting of 18 medical, three motor vehicles, three fires and three miscellaneous.
- 3. Police Department
 Reported the Police Departments statistics since the last meeting. The department has had 196 calls for service. 27 reports have been generated, 6 crash reports, 62 citations written with 14 warnings. The department's upcoming events consist of May 21st is the last day for applications for the Weapons familiarization and Gun Safety Course. Friday May 23rd is Bingo Night. Friday May 23rd is Liberty County High School Graduation, and Saturday May 24th, is Bradwell Institute's Graduation. The administrative office will be closed for Memorial Day on Monday May 26th. Wednesday May 28th is the Weapons Familiarization and Gun Safety Course. Thursday May 29 is the Neighborhood Watch Meeting.

X. Mayor's Update

Stated she and the Council would look at amending the Budget at the meeting scheduled for May 20, 2025 at 6:00 PM. She stated she is meeting with all department heads and reviewing their budget. She met with Chief Maxwell, and they trimmed 200K off of his budget. She will send the areas that were cut to the council via email.

XI. Council Comments:

Mayor Pro Tem Lovette commented that the Elected Officials attended GMA's Small Cities Conference that was held in Tifton. She said it is necessary for the elected officials to attend because these sessions put out good information. She added that with the information that was given to the council during the workshop session, cuts must be made to keep Walthourville.

Councilmember Boston commented that the city received some sobering news from the CPA tonight. He added that we must take a serious look at the financials. We cannot continue operating in the manner that we have been. Negative numbers are increasing (expenses). We must make drastic cuts and possibly eliminate some departments if not we will end up losing the city.

Councilmember Underwood made no comments. He announced that an AAU Football Team would be in the City Hall Parking lot from 8:00 AM-3:00 PM for a car wash. Mayor Hayes asked, how will they get water. CM Underwood said they will have their own water.

Councilmember Kelly commented that she agrees with Councilmember Boston about the finances.

Councilmember Dodd: commented that June 1st, officially opens the Hurricane Season. Tuesday May 20th will be a kickoff meeting for the season. He announced that he will do a Hurricane Preparation Briefing for the City of Walthourville at a later date.

- XII. Executive Session: Was held during the Mayor and Council's Workshop that began at 4:00 PM. The Mayor and Council entered the Executive Session at 5:15 PM for Litigation and exited at 5:50 PM.
